On 2/14/2022 SIO (b)(6) ran a criminal history check and N-Force query on Jeremy Turner (no hits).

On 2/15/2022 SIO (b)(6) conducted an inspection with Jeremy Turner. The inspection period covered 2/15/2021 through 2/15/2022.

Turner signed the Acknowledgement of Federal Firearms Regulations on 2/15/2022. On 2/15/2022 SIO (b)(6) discussed each of the violations that would be cited on a Report of Violations. SIO (b)(6) advised Turner that the report would be created and emailed to him at a later date. Turner signed the Report of Violations on 2/26/2022.

The licensee had an application inspection in October 2012. On 10/25/2012 Turner signed an Acknowledgement of Federal Firearms Regulations. On 9/20/2016 Turner was inspected and cited for 27 CFR 478.125(e) and 27 CFR 478.124(b). Turner signed an Acknowledgement of Federal Firearms Regulations. On 12/19/2018 Turner was inspected and was not cited for any violations. Turner signed an Acknowledgement of Federal Firearms Regulations.

During this inspection period, the licensee filed multiple sales report involving firearms.

The licensee was not associated with any traces.

Prior to the inspection, SIO (b)(6) obtained a FFL audit log. The audit log showed two transaction (both proceed). The licensee has not had any NICS denials.

The inspection did not reveal any suspicious or prohibited purchasers. The inspection did not indicate that the licensee was associated with any violent crime.

The licensee qualifies for revocation based on a violation of 27 CFR 478.102(c) and 27 CFR 478.124(a). Both violations involve the same firearm transaction involving (b)(6) the licensee failed to initiate a new NICS check and ATF Form 4473 after a 30-day lapse of the initial NICS check.

Jeremy Turner acknowledged that he failed to complete a new ATF Form 4473 and NICS check. He stated that he screwed up by not completing a new NICS check. Turner stated that he knew of the requirements, but he didn't think about it at the time of the transfer.

Under the provisions of 18 U.S.C. § 923(e) and 27 C.F.R. § 478.73, notice is hereby given that the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives ("ATF") intends to revoke the Federal firearms license held by Jeremy Owen Turner d/b/a Droptine Firearms ("Licensee"), a Dealer in Firearms Other Than Destructive Devices. Specifically, the Director, Industry Operations, United States Department of Justice, ATF, Kansas City Field Division, has reason to believe that Licensee willfully violated the provisions of the Gun Control Act of 1968, as amended, 18 U.S.C. Chapter 44, and the regulations issued thereunder, 27 C.F.R. Part 478 (collectively, "GCA") as described herein.

### **Compliance History**

ATF first issued a Federal firearms license to Licensee in 2012. The laws and regulations issued under the GCA were reviewed as part of the application inspection. Subsequently, ATF conducted compliance inspections of Licensee in 2016 and 2018.

### **Current Inspection**

On February 15, 2022, ATF began a compliance inspection of Licensee's premises that revealed the following:

#### **Background Check Violation:**

1. On one occasion, Licensee willfully transferred a firearm to an unlicensed person without first contacting the National Instant Criminal Background Check System ("NICS") before allowing the transfer, in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 922(t) and 27 C.F.R. § 478.102. See Appendix ¶ 1.

#### **ATF Form 4473 Violations:**

2. On [ ] occasions, Licensee willfully transferred a firearm to a non-licensee without recording the date Licensee contacted NICS, any response provided by the system and/or any identification number provided by the system on the Firearms Transaction Record, ATF Form 4473, in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 923(g)(1)(A) and 27 C.F.R. § 478.124(c)(3)(iv). See Appendix ¶ 2.

#### **Acquisition and Disposition Record Violation:**

3. On [ ] occasion, Licensee willfully failed to accurately record the disposition of a firearm, in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 923(g)(1)(A) and 27 C.F.R. § 478.125(e). See Appendix ¶ 3.

Jeremy Turner d/b/a Droptine Firearms, 33679 Granite Ave, Jamesport, Missouri 64648 (“Licensee”) holds Federal firearms license # 5-43-061-01-1M-10420, a dealer in firearms other than destructive devices, issued by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (“ATF”) pursuant to the Gun Control Act of 1968 (“GCA”), as amended, 18 U.S.C. Chapter 44, and the regulations issued thereunder, 27 C.F.R. Part 478.

On June 17, 2022, ATF issued a Notice of Revocation of License, ATF Form 4500, to Licensee. This Notice was sent to Licensee’s known licensed business premises. Receipt of the Notice was certified and confirmed via USPS certified mail on June 21, 2022.

Said Notice alleged that Licensee willfully violated the provisions of the GCA and the regulations issued thereunder. The Notice further specified that if Licensee wished to challenge the revocation, it may file a request with ATF for a hearing “within 15 days after receipt of this notice.” See 18 U.S.C. § 923(f)(2); 27 C.F.R. § 478.73(b). No request for hearing was filed with ATF in accordance with the provisions of the GCA.

Therefore, for the reasons set forth in the Notice of Revocation issued on June 17, 2022, the Federal firearms license held by Jeremy Turner d/b/a Droptine Firearms is hereby REVOKED.

Please send your firearms business records to the Out-of-Business Records Center, pursuant to the requirements under 18 U.S.C. § 923(g)(4) and 27 C.F.R. § 478.127, immediately, but not later than 30 days after receipt of this notice.

## IMPORTANT NOTICE

### Selling Firearms AFTER Revocation, Expiration, or Surrender of an FFL

Former Federal Firearms licensees (FFLs) who continue to sell firearms after the revocation, expiration, or surrender of their license are subject to the same rules as persons who have never been licensed in determining whether they are "engaged in the business" of selling firearms without a license in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 922(a)(1)(A). Accordingly, former licensees who wish to dispose of any remaining business inventory must adhere to the following guidance:

Business inventory must be disposed of by the former FFL in a manner that, objectively, does not constitute being engaged in the business of dealing in firearms using the same facts and circumstances test that would apply to persons who have never been licensed.

The preferred manner of disposition is for the former licensee to:

- Arrange for another FFL to purchase the business inventory (and other assets) of the business; or
- Consign the inventory to another FFL to sell on consignment, or at auction.

Should a former FFL decide against those options, he/she should be aware that future sales - whether from his/her personal firearms collection or otherwise - will be evaluated for a potential violation of 18 U.S.C. § 922(a)(1)(A), just as would occur with a person who had never been licensed.

If a former FFL is disposing of business inventory, the fact that no purchases are made after the date of license revocation, expiration, or surrender does not immunize him/her from potential violations of 18 U.S.C. § 922(a)(1)(A). Instead, business inventory acquired through repetitive purchases while licensed are attributed to the former FFL when evaluating whether subsequent sales constitute engaging in the business of dealing in firearms without a license.
