The violation cited merits the Administrative Action (AA) recommendation of Revocation. The licensee was cited for 27 CFR 478.102(a) after he accepted an out of state concealed carry state permit (issued in Pennsylvania and not expired) in lieu of conducting the required NICS check on one occasion (12/21/21) at a local gun show. On January 31, 2022, A/S (b)(6) reviewed the assignment. Investigator (b)(6) recommended a DIO Held Warning Conference (WC) in lieu of Revocation. A/S (b)(6) is recommending Revocation in accordance with current policy as an extraordinary circumstance does not appear to be present. On this date, A/S (b)(6) and Investigator (b)(6) finalized the 8C MCP BP thoroughly documenting the violation and forwarded the assignment to DIO LeDoux for final review and recommendation including approval of the 8C MCP BP. On February 4, 2022, ADAD accepted into the MCP as a Revocation due to lack of "extraordinary" circumstances around the violation. On April 28, 2022, DIO sent NOR to licensee and a Hearing was requested and scheduled for August 2, 2022. On July 29, 2022, the licensee voluntarily surrendered his license and no longer wanted a Hearing. The records were provided to Investigator (b)(6) at the Youngstown FO and sent to the OOBRC the week of August 15, 2022. On August 12, 2022, DIO sent the Final NOR to the licensee and DAD approved removal from the MCP and A/S to close the assignment in Spartan.

Pursuant to the provisions of 18 U.S.C. § 923(e) and 27 C.F.R. § 478.73, notice is hereby given that the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (“ATF”), intends to revoke the Federal firearms license held by Joshua C. Owens, Jr. (“Licensee”). Specifically, the Director of Industry Operations (“DIO”), United States Department of Justice, ATF, Columbus Field Division, has reason to believe that Licensee, an (01) Dealer in firearms other than destructive devices, willfully violated the provisions of the Gun Control Act of 1968 as amended, 18 U.S.C. Chapter 44, and the regulations issued thereunder, 27 C.F.R. Part 478 (collectively, “GCA”) as described herein.

### **Compliance History**

ATF first issued a Federal firearms license to Licensee on June 22, 2021, following a telephonic qualification inspection due to COVID-19 on May 14, 2021. The laws and regulations issued under the GCA were reviewed as part of the qualification inspection.

### **Current Inspection**

On January 24, 2022, ATF began its first compliance inspection of Licensee’s premises that revealed the following violation:

### **Background Check Violation**

1. On one (1) occasion, Licensee willfully transferred one (1) firearm to an unlicensed person without first contacting the National Instant Criminal Background Check System (“NICS”) and failed to complete a background-check before allowing the transfer, in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 922(t) and 27 C.F.R. § 478.102(a). See Appendix ¶ 1.

Joshua C. Owens, Jr. ("Licensee") held a Federal firearms license issued by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives ("ATF") pursuant to the Gun Control Act of 1968, as amended, 18 U.S.C. Chapter 44, and the regulations issued thereunder, 27 C.F.R. Part 478 (collectively, "GCA").

On April 28, 2022 ATF issued a Notice to Revoke or Suspend and/or Impose Civil Fine, ATF Form 5300.4 (4500), to Licensee. The Notice was sent with the United States Post Service (USPS) by certified mail, return receipt requested. The USPS delivered the notice on April 30, 2022.

The Notice alleged Licensee willfully violated the provisions of the GCA. The Notice further specified that if Licensee wanted a hearing to review the notice, he should file a request with ATF for such hearing within 15 days after receipt of the notice and in accord with 18 U.S.C. § 923(f)(2) and 27 C.F.R. § 478.73(b). He requested a hearing by letter dated May 2, 2022, which was scheduled for August 2, 2022.

However, on July 27, 2022, Licensee sent an email indicating that he did not want to have a hearing. On July 28, 2022, he provided a Notice of Discontinuance of Business indicating he understood that the voluntary surrender of the license would result in the issuance of a Final Notice of Revocation. On August 9, 2022 he surrendered his license and records to ATF.

For the reasons set forth in the Notice of Revocation, the Federal firearms license held by Licensee is hereby REVOKED.

**IMPORTANT NOTICE**

**Selling Firearms AFTER Revocation, Expiration, or Surrender of an FFL**

Former Federal Firearms licensees (FFLs) who continue to sell firearms after the revocation, expiration, or surrender of their license are subject to the same rules as persons who have never been licensed in determining whether they are "engaged in the business" of selling firearms without a license in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 922(a)(1)(A). Accordingly, former licensees who wish to dispose of any remaining business inventory must adhere to the following guidance:

Business inventory must be disposed of by the former FFL in a manner that, objectively, does not constitute being engaged in the business of dealing in firearms using the same facts and circumstances test that would apply to persons who have never been licensed.

The preferred manner of disposition is for the former licensee to:

- Arrange for another FFL to purchase the business inventory (and other assets) of the business; or
- Consign the inventory to another FFL to sell on consignment, or at auction.

Should a former FFL decide against those options, he/she should be aware that future sales - whether from his/her personal firearms collection or otherwise - will be evaluated for a potential violation of 18 U.S.C. § 922(a)(1)(A), just as would occur with a person who had never been licensed.

If a former FFL is disposing of business inventory, the fact that no purchases are made after the date of license revocation, expiration, or surrender does not immunize him/her from potential violations of 18 U.S.C. § 922(a)(1)(A). Instead, business inventory acquired through repetitive purchases while licensed are attributed to the former FFL when evaluating whether subsequent sales constitute engaging in the business of dealing in firearms without a license.
